Elective EMI courses with more than nine credits (not included in graduation credits) will receive a subsidy for English test registration fees.

Description:

- In response to the promotion of the 2030 National Bilingual Plan, our school has proposed this
 plan to encourage students to take EMI courses (the English courses announced by the
 Curriculum Section).
- 2. Students who take the elective EMI courses with nine or more credits not included in the graduation credits will receive a subsidy for a TOEIC test registration fee of NT\$ 1,600 per person, or other English tests are subject to a maximum of NT\$ 1,600 according to the actual registration amount. If students reach the benchmarks for Foreign Language Proficiency Tests, they can apply for the best, either of them.
- 3. To apply for the registration fee subsidy, students need to prepare the following documents and proceed in March and October each year: proof of completing 9 EMI credits (not included in graduation credits), payment receipt, and transcripts.
- 4. Students who have taken EMI courses for nine credits or more not included in the graduation credits, and taking an official English Proficiency Test once, will be deemed to have passed the English Proficiency Graduation Threshold. They can apply for the certification in the Foreign Language Center and log in to "Pass English Proficiency Test Threshold" in their departments.
